Sindh

HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows.

METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

Moist currents of Mild intensity from Arabian sea are penetrating upper parts of the country & lower Sindh up to 5000 feet.

WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Isolated wind-thunderstorm/rain is expected over Karachi.

WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS

Wet spell is likely to increase over the upper parts of the country and vanish from Sindh.

SUBJECT: - RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST:

I: HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:

All the Major Rivers are flowing in the state of their normal flows. Mild Flows are expected in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division.

II: METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:

- a. Yesterday's well marked low pressure area over Gulf of Kutch has weakened into trough.
- b. Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Northern parts of Afghanistan today lies over Northeast Afghanistan.
- c. Weak Seasonal Low lies over North Balochistan.
- d. Moist currents of Mild intensity from Arabian sea are penetrating upper parts of the country & lower Sindh upto 5000 feet.

III: WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:

Scattered wind-thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Kohat, Bannu, Rawalpindi & Gujranwala Divisions. Isolated wind-thunderstorm/rain is expected over Karachi, Makran Coast, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Lahore, Multan, DG Khan, Bahawalpur & DI Khan Divisions along with Northeast Balochistan.

IV: WEATHER OUTLOOK FOR NEXT 48-HOURS:

Wet spell is likely to increase over the upper parts of the country and vanish from Sindh & Coastal Balochistan.
