Assignment Title: **Developing Community Based Disaster Risk Management (CBDRM) model for Sindh and piloting of CBDRM activities**

The Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) Sindh, Govt. of Sindh, has received credit from World Bank for “Sindh Resilience Project” for five years tenure. The SRP aims that the PDMA Sindh, DDMA, line depts and the communities be resilient and strengthened to manage natural and human-induced hazards and disasters proactively in all phases of disaster that includes but not limited to; Pre-disaster (*Mitigation, Preparedness*), during the disaster (*Rescue, Response, Relief*) and Post-disaster (*Recovery, Rehabilitation and Re-construction*).

The consulting services (“the Services”) include services for the Development of Community Based Disaster Risk Management (CBDRM) model for Sindh and Piloting of CBDRM activities.

The interested firm shall be a consultancy firm incorporated for at least 10 years offering similar services. The firm should provide details (documentary evidence e.g. contract award or reference letter from clients stating scope of services) of all such projects for the last 10 years during which they were completed. The firm should have adequate professional staff working in the relevant areas, as detailed in ToRs. The shortlisting criteria is given as under;

A) Technical Capacity	Max. Points
1. Consultants should have 10 years experience relating to community level trainings delivery. ( Per year 2 marks )	20
2. The consultant firm should have 10 years experience of research and curriculum development along with preparation of training manuals, toolkits and participants workbooks etc. (Per year 2 marks )	20
3. The consultant should have 10 years experience of delivery of Training of Trainers (ToT) courses. (Per year 1 marks)	10
4. The consultant should have completed at least 2 assignments of comparable scale and complexity. (Per assignment 10 marks)	20
5. The consultant should have completed at least 2 assignments related to CBDRM activity with National/Provincial disaster management authorities/organizations (Per assignment 10 marks)	20
6. Organizational strength in terms of Senior management & Training facilities (5 marks each)	10

**Note: Minimum required marks for shortlisting = 70**
