

Request for Bids

Contract Title: **Construction of Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) Head Office, Rescue Head Office & Rescue Station at Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Karachi, Sindh**

1. The *Government of Sindh* has received financing from the World Bank toward the cost of the Sindh Resilience Project (PDMA Component) and intends to apply part of the proceeds toward payments of share under the contract for "Construction of Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) Head Office, Rescue Head Office & Rescue Station at Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Karachi, Sindh".
2. The Project Director Sindh Resilience Project (PDMA Component) now invites sealed Bids from eligible Bidders for "Construction of Provincial Disaster Management Authority (PDMA) Head Office, Rescue Head Office & Rescue Station at Gulshan-e-Iqbal, Karachi, Sindh" The Works are to be completed in 18 months.
3. Bidding will be conducted through National Competitive Procurement using a Request for Bids (RFB) as specified in the World Bank's "Procurement Regulations for IPF Borrowers" (July 2016) revised November 2017 and August 2018 ("Procurement Regulations"), and is open to all Bidders as defined in the Procurement Regulations. Following Method (One-Envelope Bidding Process)
4. Bidding Documents (and additional copies) may be purchased from Office of the SRP-PDMA Component, 26-C, Khayaban-e-Jami, Defence Housing Authority Phase-VII, Karachi for a non-refundable fee of Rs. 5,000/-(Rupees Five Thousand Only) for each set. Interested bidders may obtain the same information at the same address.
5. Bids must be delivered to Project Director Sindh Resilience Project (PDMA Component) 26-C, Khayaban-e-Jami, Defence Housing Authority Phase-VII, Karachi on or before **7 June 2021 at 1200hrs**. The bids will be opened on the same date at 1200hrs PST. Electronic Bidding will not be permitted. Late Bids will be rejected. Bids will be publicly opened in the presence of the Bidders' designated representatives and anyone who chooses to attend at the same address below.
6. Bids shall be valid for a period of 90 days after bid opening as mentioned in the bidding documents. All Bids must be accompanied by a Bid security of PKR 11.50 million (In shape of Unconditional Bank Guarantee only) of the Bid Price.
7. Due to prevailing Covid-19 situation pre-bid conference will not be held, any questions / queries may be delivered to the address given below in writing at least 10 days before the deadlines for submission of bids.
8. All bidders shall be required to submit with their bids, qualification information specified in the bidding documents. This information shall be used to establish through Post Qualification whether the bidder is qualified to perform the work.
9. Bidders are required to submit on item rates basis (not on the basis of composite schedule Rates with Percentage premium) and the rates and amounts (in Rupees) must be filled by the bidder for each item in the Bill of Quantities and provide a total price. Non-Compliance may result in rejection of bid.



10. Bidders should give their best and final price in their bids as no negotiations are expected.
11. As provided in the bidding documents, bidders engaged in corrupt or fraudulent practices (including collusion/ pooling) will be declared ineligible, either indefinitely or for a stated period of time, to be awarded a contract financed by the World Bank.
12. Attention is drawn to the Procurement Regulations requiring the Borrower to disclose information on the successful bidder's beneficial ownership, as part of the Contract Award Notice, using the Beneficial Ownership Disclosure Form as included in the bidding document."
