SUBJECT: - MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY.

The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued Daily Weather Report on 30th July, 2015 at 1000 PST and *BULLETIN No. A-B 046/15*, dated 30th July, 2015 (10:20 hours PST), portions relevant to Sindh Province are reproduced here under:

Synoptic Situation:

Seasonal low lies over northwest of Balochistan. Well marked low pressure lies over northeast Rajasthan (India) under the influence of this low pressure, monsoon currents are penetrating into upper and central parts of the country and likely to continue in coming days.

Weather Outlook for next 24 Hrs:

Rain-thundershower is expected at isolated places in Sukkur division.

Accordingly, I am directed to request you to ensure that all necessary measures including activation of Rain Emergency Centers / District Emergency Operation Centers of your respective DDMA for effective response mechanism, wherever required are taken. It may also be ensured that sufficient resources such as dewatering pumps are **deployed at low lying areas.**

3. The necessary measures taken by District Disaster Management Authorities in accordance to their District Disaster Management Plans/mandates may kindly be communicated to PDMA Sindh via return fax on **021-99251463.**

4. The Deputy Commissioners are further requested to keep close liaison with the line departments. **It is further pointed out that there is expectation of heavy downpour over Koh-e-Suleiman range from 31st July-2015 to 2nd August-2015, which may generate flash flooding in the districts of kashmore, Jacobabad, Kamber Shahdadkot and Dadu. Accordingly, the concerned Deputy Commissioners and concerned Authorities are requested to take requisite precautionary steps.**
