Subject: - **RIVERS SITUATION AND QUALITATIVE FLOOD FORECAST**

I am directed to refer to Pakistan Meteorological Department Flood Forecasting Division Bulletin No. A75/20, dated 28.08.2020, 11:20 hours (PST), under which following has been forecasted:

**HYDROLOGICAL SITUATION:**

- River Chenab at Marala, Khanki & Qadirabad is in High Flood level, River Indus at Tarbela, Chashma, Guddu & Sukkur and River Jhelum at Mangla & Rasul are in Low Flood Level.
- River Chenab at Trimmu is likely to attain Medium to High Flood level on 30th August-2020.
- Flows are also likely to increase upto Medium flood level in the Nullahs of Rivers Chenab & Ravi and Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division during next 24 Hours.


**METEOROLOGICAL FEATURES:**

- a) Yesterday's Depression over North Orissa today lies over North Chattisgarh and adjoining East Madhya Pradesh.
- b) Yesterday's trough of westerly wave over Kashmir is moving away Eastwards.
- c) Weak Seasonal Low lies over West Balochistan.
- d) Weak moist currents from Arabian Sea is penetrating upper parts of the country upto 5000 feet.

**WEATHER FORECAST FOR NEXT 24-HOURS:**

Scattered thunderstorm/rain of moderate intensity is expected over the upper catchments of all the Major Rivers along with Peshawar, Kohat, DI Khan, Rawalpindi, Lahore, Gujranwala, Sargodha & DG Khan Divisions. Isolated thunderstorm/rain is expected over South & Southeast Sindh, Northeast Balochistan along with Multan, Faisalabad, Sahiwal & Bahawalpur Divisions
